

## **Procedures for determining player jersey numbers**

There will be no duplicate jersey numbers across an age group.

Upon finalizing the rosters for the entire age group, the managers should work together to determine the jersey numbers with input from the players. The priority is as following:

1. Players that are already at the Club and in the age group get to keep their existing jersey number. The team managers should confirm the player's desire to keep their number or allow the player to pick from any remaining number if they desire to make a change. Players with the longest tenure at the Club have priority, regardless of which team they are on within the age group.
2. Players that are already at the Club but moving to a new age group get to select numbers next. The order will be based on tenure at the Club, regardless of which team they are on within the age group.
3. New players to the Club will select from the remaining numbers. In order to accomplish this as fairly as possible, all new players will be given a list of remaining numbers and provide the manager with three desired choices in order of preference. The manager will then be responsible for assigning numbers by trying to give as many players as possible their first choice. This process will be repeated for each of the teams in succession (black, red, gray).

Each team should purchase additional jerseys for guest players. The jersey numbers should be selected by the team manager from the remaining numbers (black, red, gray).

A master list of number assignments for the entire age group should be kept by the black team manager.
